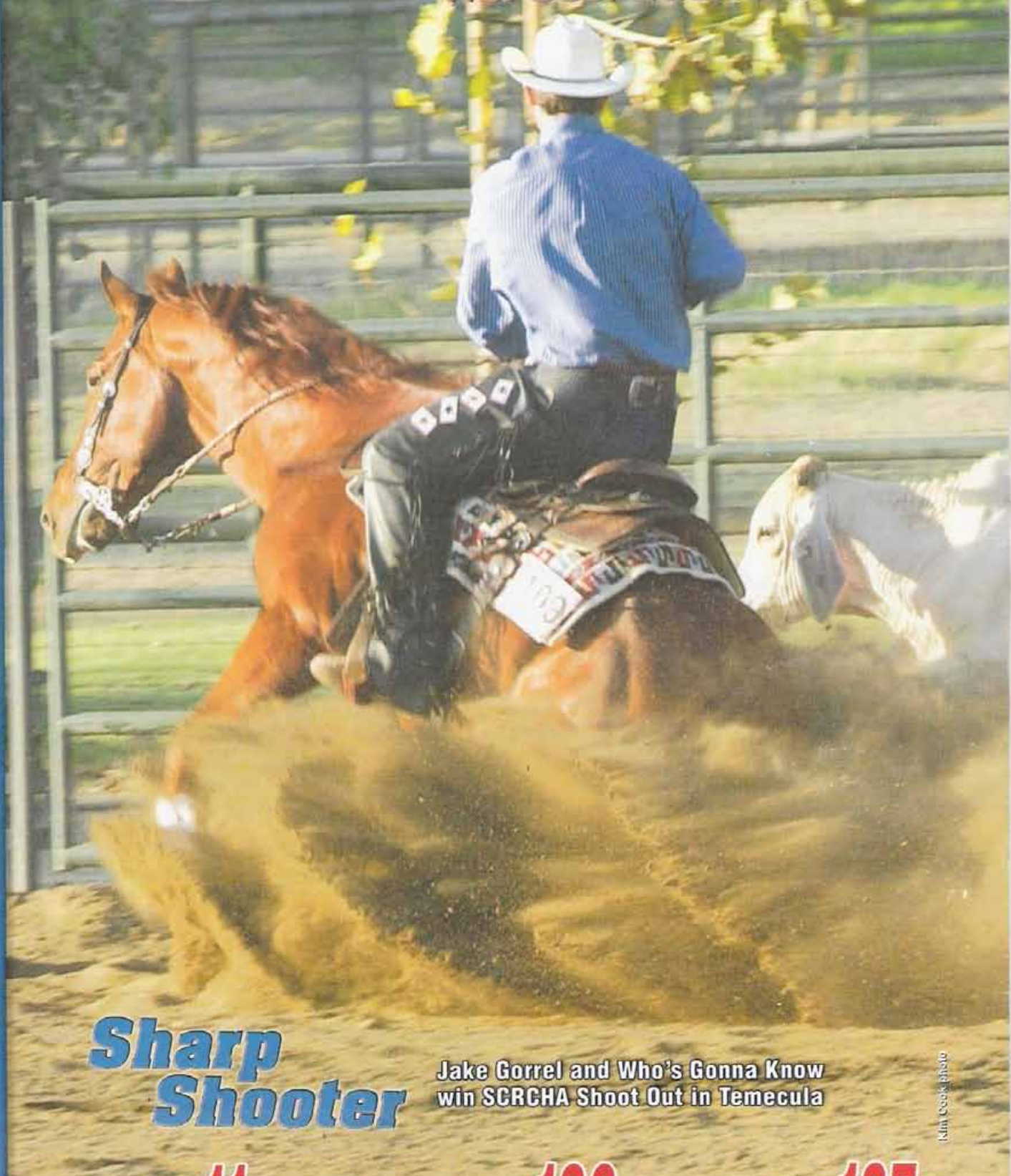

## Jake Gorrell, Who's Gonna Know win SCRCHA year-end Shoot Out

Organizers give away three saddles at 2nd annual event

**T**EMECULA — Fans of reined cow horse shows were treated to a good show as the Southern California Reined Cow Horse Association ended its show season with its grand finale, called the Shoot Out. Jake Gorrell of Hanford, Calif., won the Open Championship riding Who's Gonna Know, owned by Kim Ramsden.

In its second year, the SCRCHA Shoot Out was a two-day show held Oct. 13-14 at Casner Ranch in Temecula. Throughout the past year, SCRCHA members competed and rode to qualify for the event. Cheers from a crowd of enthusiastic spectators also added to the event's atmosphere.

Organizers of the show said they were able to meet their goal of giving away three Custom Bob's Saddles and other additional awards, said Cindy Mendoza, president of SCRCHA. The competition was held after the last class on Sunday, Oct. 14.

There were 24 riders competing to win one

of the saddles. Open and Non Pro riders had a "shoot off" down the fence, with the highest fence score from each division taking the saddle. The Non Pro Ltd Riders aimed for their best boxing score.

Tia Harari rode her horse, Fresno's Poco Smokum, to win the Non Pro Championship.

Highest Scoring Youth Rider was Kelley Crawford aboard Lena Nu Flash.

Highest Scoring Reserve Champion was Murray Thompson riding Smart Time Tuck.

Todd Lambert rode Gonna Be Crazy to win the Limited Championship.

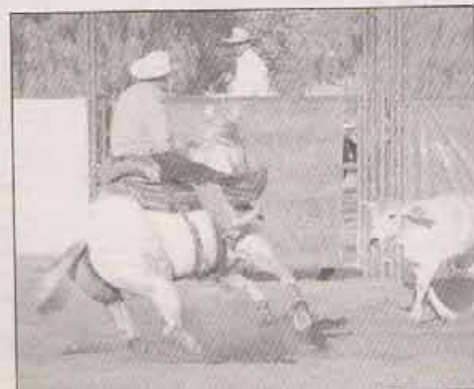
